Thank you for considering the Civil War Days in the Battle Born State School Day program for your students. Here is a small explanation of how the program will function, and how we can all work together to make it a successful fun filled day of learning for everyone involved.

- Students will be broken up into (somewhat) evenly numbered groups to “cycle through” the six stations. Whole classes will be kept together, even if it means having some groups larger than others; however, whole schools may not be kept together in the same group.
- We have found it necessary to have a 10:1 student to adult ratio, so please plan on bringing a couple of adult/parent chaperons with you in addition to yourself and your aide (if you have one).
- You are welcome to bring sack snacks/lunches to be consumed during the break. However, Ray’s Barbecue will also be available! Costs average between \$2.00 and \$6.00 for most menu items.
- You (and your students/chaperons) are welcome to bring a picnic blanket for use during the welcome, break, and closing. Due to the program being outdoors, it is also advised to bring a hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, and water to drink.

**PLEASE NOTE: The re-enactors here today are on a volunteer basis and pay for their own equipment/clothing/artifacts, both antique and reproduction. Remember, you are responsible for your students!**
